**ENGROSSED
HOUSE BILL No. 1419**

DIGEST OF HB 1419 (Updated February 16, 2000 2:28 PM - DI 98)

Citations Affected: IC 9-18; IC 16-19; noncode.

Synopsis: Anatomical gift funding. Establishes the anatomical gift promotion fund for the purpose of receiving donations of money collected by the bureau of motor vehicles for organizations that promote the procurement of organs for anatomical gifts. Provides that donations of money made in conjunction with vehicle registrations are to be deposited with the treasurer of state and distributed to the anatomical gift promotion fund by the auditor of state. Provides that the fund is to be administered by the state department of health. Requires the auditor of state to distribute \$50,000 before July 29, 2000, to the Indiana Donation Alliance Foundation to establish a statewide telephone donor and patient referral system.

Effective: July 1, 2000.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1419

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-18-2-16, AS AMENDED BY P.L.181-1999,
 2 SECTION 13, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 3 JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 16. (a) A person who owns a vehicle must sign an
 4 application in ink to register the vehicle.
 5 (b) An application to register a vehicle must contain the following:
 6 (1) The:
 7 (A) name, bona fide residence, and mailing address, including
 8 the name of the county, of the person who owns the vehicle; or
 9 (B) business address, including the name of the county, of the
 10 person that owns the vehicle if the person is a firm, a
 11 partnership, an association, a corporation, a limited liability
 12 company, or a unit of government.
 13 If the vehicle that is being registered has been leased and is
 14 subject to the motor vehicle excise tax under IC 6-6-5 or the
 15 commercial vehicle excise tax under IC 6-6-5.5, the application
 16 must contain the address of the person who is leasing the vehicle.
 17 If the vehicle that is being registered has been leased and is not

1 subject to the motor vehicle excise tax under IC 6-6-5 or the
 2 commercial vehicle excise tax under IC 6-6-5.5, the application
 3 must contain the address of the person who owns the vehicle, the
 4 person who is the lessor of the vehicle, or the person who is the
 5 lessee of the vehicle. If a leased vehicle is to be registered under
 6 the International Registration Plan, the registration procedures are
 7 governed by the terms of the plan.

8 (2) A brief description of the vehicle to be registered, including
 9 the following information if available:

10 (A) The name of the manufacturer of the vehicle.

11 (B) The vehicle identification number.

12 (C) The manufacturer's rated capacity if the vehicle is a truck,
 13 tractor, trailer, or semitrailer.

14 (D) The type of body of the vehicle.

15 (E) The model year of the vehicle.

16 (F) Any other information reasonably required by the bureau
 17 to enable the bureau to determine if the vehicle may be
 18 registered. The bureau may request the person applying for
 19 registration to provide the vehicle's odometer reading.

20 (3) A space on the application in which the person registering the
 21 vehicle may indicate the person's desire to donate money to
 22 organizations that promote the procurement of organs for
 23 anatomical gifts. The space on the application must:

24 (A) allow the person registering the vehicle to indicate the
 25 amount the person desires to donate; and

26 (B) provide that the minimum amount a person may donate is
 27 one dollar (\$1).

28 Funds collected under this subdivision shall be ~~distributed by the~~
 29 ~~bureau as directed by the Indiana department of state health under~~
 30 **deposited with the treasurer of state in a special account. The**
 31 **auditor of state shall monthly distribute the money in the**
 32 **special account to the anatomical gift promotion fund**
 33 **established by IC 16-19-3-26.** The bureau may deduct from the
 34 funds collected under this subdivision the costs incurred by the
 35 bureau in implementing and administering this subdivision.

36 (c) The department of state revenue may audit records of persons
 37 who register trucks, trailers, semitrailers, buses, and rental cars under
 38 the International Registration Plan to verify the accuracy of the
 39 application and collect or refund fees due.

40 SECTION 2. IC 16-19-3-26 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 41 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 26. (a) **The anatomical**
 42 **gift promotion fund is established. The fund consists of amounts**

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1 distributed to the fund by the auditor of state under IC 9-18-2-16.

2 (b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not
3 currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same
4 manner as other public funds are invested. Interest that accrues
5 from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.

6 (c) The state department shall administer the fund. Any
7 expenses incurred in administering the fund shall be paid from the
8 fund.

9 (d) The state department shall select appropriate organ procurement
10 organizations to which the funds generated under IC 9-18-2-16(b)(3)
11 money deposited in the fund shall be distributed.

12 (e) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not
13 revert to the state general fund.

14 SECTION 3. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000] (a) Before July 15,
15 2000, the bureau of motor vehicles shall deposit with the treasurer
16 of state in the special account required by IC 9-18-2-16, as
17 amended by this act, all donations collected by the bureau before
18 July 1, 2000, under IC 9-18-2-16, as amended by this act. Before
19 July 29, 2000, the auditor of state shall distribute the money
20 deposited in the special account under this SECTION as follows:

21 (1) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to the Indiana Donation
22 Alliance Foundation for the establishment of a statewide
23 telephone donor and patient referral system.

24 (2) All money remaining in the special account after the
25 payment required under subdivision (1) to the anatomical gift
26 promotion fund established under IC 16-19-3-26, as amended
27 by this act.

28 (b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2001.
