SENATE BILL No. 343

DIGEST OF SB 343 (Updated February 23, 2000 5:24 PM - DI 84)

Citations Affected: IC 9-18.

Synopsis: License plates. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to design and issue a special group recognition license plate to honor Indiana Vietnam era veterans. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to design and issue a license plate to honor veterans who have received the Silver Star medal. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to design and issue a special group recognition license plate to honor Indiana Korean era veterans. Allows an individual who is eligible to receive a Vietnam era, Silver Star, or Korean era license plate to receive a personalized license plate. Exempts Vietnam era, Silver Star, and Korean era license plates from minimum sales requirements. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to issue an Indiana child protection trust license plate. Requires the additional fee required for the Indiana child protection trust license plate to be deposited in the Indiana child protection trust fund and distributed to an organization established to raise funds for child adoption agencies, crisis pregnancy centers, or any other charitable organization approved by the organization established (Continued next page)

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 343

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-18-2-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
2 [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2001]: Sec. 7. (a) A person who owns a
3 vehicle subject to registration shall register each vehicle owned by the
4 person as follows:
- 5 (1) A vehicle subject to section 8 of this chapter shall be
6 registered under section 8.
 - 7 (2) A vehicle not subject to section 8 of this chapter or to the
8 International Registration Plan shall be registered before:
 - 9 (A) March 1 of each year; or
 - 10 (B) an earlier date subsequent to January 1 of each year as set
11 by the bureau.
 - 12 (3) School buses owned by a school corporation are exempt from
13 annual registration but are subject to registration under
14 IC 20-9.1-4.
 - 15 (4) Subject to subsection (f), a vehicle subject to the International
16 Registration Plan shall be registered before April 1 of each year.
 - 17 (b) Registrations and re-registrations under this section are for the

1 calendar year. Registration and re-registration for school buses owned
2 by a school corporation may be for more than a calendar year.

3 (c) License plates for a vehicle subject to this section may be
4 displayed during:

5 (1) the calendar year for which the vehicle is registered; and

8 (B) before the date that the vehicle must be re-registered.

Sec. 1. The bureau of motor vehicles shall design and issue a Korean era veteran license plate. The Korean era veteran license plate shall be designed and issued as a special group recognition license plate under IC 9-18-25.

Sec. 2. A Korean era veteran license plate designed under IC 9-18-25 must include the following:

- (1) A basic design for the plate with consecutive numbers or letters, or both, to properly identify the vehicle.**
- (2) A background design, an emblem, or colors that designate the license plate as a Korean era veteran license plate.**
- (3) Any other information the bureau considers necessary.**

Sec. 3. Beginning January 1, 2001, a person who is a resident of Indiana and served in the armed forces of the United States any time from June 27, 1950, until January 31, 1955, may apply for and receive one (1) or more Korean era veteran license plates upon doing the following:

- (1) Completing an application for a Korean era veteran license plate.**
- (2) Paying the fees under section 4 of this chapter.**

Sec. 4. The fees for a Korean era veteran license plate are the appropriate fee under IC 9-29-5-38(a)(1) and the fee under IC 9-29-5-38(a)(2).

SECTION 13. IC 9-18-50 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2001]:

(c) The annual fee described in subsection (a)(2) shall be deposited in the fund established by section 4 of this chapter.

Sec. 4. (a) The Indiana UAW trust fund is established.

(b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same manner as other public trust funds are invested. Interest that accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.

(c) The commissioner shall administer the fund. Expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from money in the fund.

(d) On June 30 of each year, the commissioner shall distribute the money from the fund to the general fund of the Indiana UAW, a labor organization under Section 501 (c)(5) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(e) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not revert to the state general fund."
