MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 205 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 14-8-2-27.5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 27.5. "Bow", for
- 5 purposes of **IC 14-22-31 and** IC 14-22-40, has the meaning set forth
- 6 in IC 14-22-40-1.
- 7 SECTION 2. IC 14-8-2-91.5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 8 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 91.5. "Firearm", for
- 9 purposes of **IC 14-22-31 and** IC 14-22-40, has the meaning set forth
- 10 in IC 14-22-40-3."
- 11 Page 2, after line 5, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 12 "SECTION 4. IC 14-22-31-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 13 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 4. Upon receipt of an
- 14 application, the department shall do the following:
- 15 (1) Inspect the following:
- 16 (A) The proposed shooting preserve.
- 17 (B) The facilities for propagating the game birds, **white tail**
- 18 **deer**, or exotic mammals.
- 19 (C) The cover.
- 20 (D) The capability of the applicant to maintain such an
- 21 operation.
- 22 (2) If found feasible, approve the application and issue a license
- 23 to the applicant.
- 24 SECTION 5. IC 14-22-31-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS

1 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 7. A person issued a
 2 license under section 4 of this chapter may propagate and offer for
 3 hunting the following animals that are captive reared and released:

4 (1) Pheasant, quail, chukar partridges, properly marked mallard
 5 ducks, and other game bird species that the department
 6 determines by rule.

7 (2) Species of exotic mammals that the department determines by
 8 rule.

9 **(3) White tail deer.**

10 SECTION 6. IC 14-22-31-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 11 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 8. (a) A person may not
 12 take game birds, **white tail deer**, and exotic mammals on a shooting
 13 preserve unless the person has a hunting license required under this
 14 article, except nonresidents of Indiana who must possess a special
 15 license to shoot on licensed shooting preserves.

16 (b) The department:

17 (1) shall issue special licenses; and

18 (2) may appoint owners or managers of shooting preserves as
 19 agents to sell special licenses.

20 (c) A special license expires December 31 of the year issued.

21 (d) The fee for a special license is eight dollars and seventy-five
 22 cents (\$8.75). All fees shall be deposited in the fish and wildlife fund.

23 SECTION 7. IC 14-22-31-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 24 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 9. (a) **Except for white**
 25 **tail deer**, a person may take wild animals from a shooting preserve
 26 only during September, October, November, December, January,
 27 February, March, or April.

28 **(b) A person may take white tail deer from a shooting preserve**
 29 **with a bow or a firearm during the seasons established by the**
 30 **director under IC 14-22-2-6 to take a deer with:**

31 **(1) a bow and arrow; and**

32 **(2) a firearm.**

33 SECTION 8. IC 14-22-31-10 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 34 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 10. The licensee of a
 35 shooting preserve shall issue a bill of sale designating game birds,
 36 **white tail deer**, or exotic mammals lawfully taken upon the shooting
 37 preserve. The bill of sale must accompany all game birds and exotic
 38 mammals removed from the shooting preserve. The licensee shall
 39 retain a copy of all bills of sale issued to persons removing game birds,

- 1 **white tail deer**, or exotic mammals from the shooting preserve. The
- 2 bills of sale are subject to inspection by the fish and wildlife division
- 3 at any time."
- 4 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
