MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1124 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between lines 15 and 16, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 3. IC 16-21-2-15 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000]: Sec. 15. (a) A hospital with
- 4 at least one hundred (100) beds shall have on duty at all times at least
- 5 one (1) physician licensed under IC 25-22.5. Implementation of this
- 6 section shall be subject to rules promulgated by the state department of
- 7 health to ensure continuous coverage by physicians licensed under
- 8 IC 25-22.5 for inpatient emergencies.
- 9 (b) **A hospital subject to this section must establish policies that**
- 10 **govern immediate response to inpatient medical emergencies.**
- 11 **These policies shall address:**
- 12 (1) **the composition of the hospital's emergency response**
- 13 **team, which shall be a collaborative, interdisciplinary body**
- 14 **with at least one (1) member who:**
- 15 (A) **has successfully completed advanced cardiac life**
- 16 **support training; and**
- 17 (B) **is not staffing the hospital's emergency department**
- 18 **while on duty as a member of the emergency response**
- 19 **team;**
- 20 (2) **the location and contents of all emergency response carts**
- 21 **for purposes of maintaining optimal efficiency and response**
- 22 **time to inpatient emergencies; and**
- 23 (3) **the annual education and training requirements for**
- 24 **emergency response team members, which must be consistent**

- 1           **with accreditation specifications or other nationally**
- 2           **recognized standards.**
- 3       **Implementation of this subsection is subject to survey by the state**
- 4       **department of health."**
- 5           Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
