## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

---

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the establishment of an interim study committee to study the feasibility of establishing shelters for the homeless and the extent to which the lack of funding has aggravated the problem of homelessness.

*Whereas, The National Law Center on Homelessness and Poverty estimates have indicated that there are over 750,000 people homeless on any given night and up to 2 million people who experience homelessness during one year; and*

*Whereas, People are homeless because of a lack of affordable housing, incomes that are too low to pay for basic living expenses, and a lack of services to help people overcome personal challenges: Therefore,*

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives  
of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,  
the Senate concurring:*

- 1 SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to establish an  
2 interim study committee to study the feasibility of establishing shelters  
3 for the homeless and the extent to which the lack of funding has  
4 aggravated the problem of homelessness.  
5 SECTION 2. That the committee, if established, shall study:  
6 (1) the feasibility of establishing shelters for the homeless; and  
7 (2) the extent to which the lack of funding has aggravated the  
8 problem of homelessness.  
9 SECTION 3. That the committee, if established, shall operate under  
10 the direction of the legislative council and that the committee shall  
11 issue a final report when directed to do so by the council.
