SENATE BILL No. 286

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-18-15-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.1-1999,
2 SECTION 26, AND AS AMENDED BY P.L.222-1999, SECTION 9,
3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY
4 1, 2002]: Sec. 1. (a) A person who is the registered owner or lessee of
5 a:
6 (1) passenger motor vehicle;
7 (2) motorcycle;
8 (3) recreational vehicle; or
9 (4) vehicle registered as a truck with a declared gross weight of
10 not more than:
11 (A) eleven thousand (11,000) pounds;
12 (B) nine thousand (9,000) pounds; or
13 (C) seven thousand (7,000) pounds;
14 registered with the bureau or who makes an application for an original
15 registration or renewal registration of a vehicle may apply to the bureau
16 for a personalized license plate to be affixed to the vehicle for which
17 registration is sought instead of the regular license plate.

 40 SECTION 2. IC 9-18-47 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
 41 A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 42 JANUARY 1, 2002]:



1 **Chapter 47. Huntington College Trust License Plates**

2 **Sec. 1. The bureau of motor vehicles shall design and issue a**
 3 **Huntington College trust license plate. The Huntington College**
 4 **trust license plate shall be designed and issued as a special group**
 5 **recognition license plate under IC 9-18-25.**

6 **Sec. 2. After December 31, 2001, a person who is eligible to**
 7 **register a vehicle under this title is eligible to receive a Huntington**
 8 **College trust license plate under this chapter upon doing the**
 9 **following:**

10 **(1) Completing an application for a Huntington College trust**
 11 **license plate.**

12 **(2) Paying the fees under section 3 of this chapter.**

13 **Sec. 3. (a) The fees for a Huntington College trust license plate**
 14 **are as follows:**

15 **(1) The appropriate fee under IC 9-29-5-38(a).**

16 **(2) An annual fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25).**

17 **(b) The annual fee referred to in subsection (a)(2) shall be**
 18 **collected by the bureau.**

19 **(c) The annual fee described in subsection (a)(2) shall be**
 20 **deposited in the fund established by section 4 of this chapter.**

21 **Sec. 4. (a) The Huntington College trust fund is established.**

22 **(b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not**
 23 **currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same**
 24 **manner as other public trust funds are invested. Interest that**
 25 **accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.**
 26 **Money in the fund is continuously appropriated for the purposes**
 27 **of this section.**

28 **(c) The commissioner shall administer the fund. Expenses of**
 29 **administering the fund shall be paid from money in the fund.**

30 **(d) On June 30 of each year the commissioner shall distribute**
 31 **the money from the fund to Huntington College.**

32 **(e) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not**
 33 **revert to the state general fund.**
