

SENATE BILL No. 400

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: None (noncode).

Synopsis: Appropriation for CHOICE in-home services. Increases the appropriations made during each year of the current biennium to the family and social services administration for the CHOICE in-home services program (the 1999 budget act appropriated \$42,623,785 for this purpose during each year of the biennium). Specifies that these appropriations do not include intragovernmental transfers to provide the nonfederal share of the Medicaid aged and disabled waiver.

Effective: Upon passage.

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January 10, 2000, read first time and referred to Committee on Finance.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning human services and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a)
- 2 **Notwithstanding P.L.273-1999, SECTION 8, the following amounts**
- 3 **are appropriated from the state general fund to the division of**
- 4 **disability, aging, and rehabilitative services of the family and social**
- 5 **services administration for total operating expense for**
- 6 **C.H.O.I.C.E. IN-HOME SERVICES:**
- 7 (1) **Forty-six million seven hundred ninety thousand four**
- 8 **hundred seventy-seven dollars (\$46,790,477) beginning July**
- 9 **1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.**
- 10 (2) **Sixty-five million one hundred twenty-three thousand**
- 11 **seven hundred eighty-five dollars (\$65,123,785) beginning**
- 12 **July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.**
- 13 (b) **Notwithstanding P.L.273-1999, SECTION 8, the**
- 14 **appropriations made by this act do not include intragovernmental**
- 15 **transfers to provide the nonfederal share of the Medicaid aged and**
- 16 **disabled waiver.**
- 17 (c) **The appropriations made by this act are in place of and not**

3 **(d) This SECTION expires July 1, 2001.**
