**MR. PRESIDENT:**

**I move** that Senate Bill 64 be amended to read as follows:

2 **satisfies the conditions of section 1.5 of this chapter"**.  
3           Page 3, line 37, after "fund" insert **"covered by this article that**  
4 **satisfies the conditions of section 1.5 of this chapter"**.  
5           Page 3, between lines 40 and 41, begin a new paragraph and insert;  
6 **"(c) The biennial appropriation under this section shall be**  
7 **deposited in the trust of each fund and used only as provided in**  
8 **section 1.5 of this chapter."**  
9           Page 4, line 37, after "governor" insert ",".  
10          Page 4, line 38, delete "and to".  
11          Page 4, line 38, after "commission" insert **", and the budget**  
12 **committee"**.  
13          Page 4, line 41, after "year" delete "." and insert **", including**  
14 **information on the following:**  
15               **(A) Investment performance.**  
16               **(B) Investment and administrative costs as a percentage of**  
17 **assets under management.**  
18               **(C) Investment asset allocation strategy.**  
19               **(D) Member services.**  
20               **(E) Member communications."**  
21          Page 7, line 7, after "governor" insert ",".  
22          Page 7, line 8, delete "and to".  
23          Page 7, line 8, after "commission" insert **", and the budget**  
24 **committee"**.  
25          Page 7, line 11, after "year" delete "." and insert **", including**  
26 **information on the following:**  
27               **(A) Investment performance.**  
28               **(B) Investment and administrative costs as a percentage of**  
29 **assets under management.**

- 1           **(C) Investment asset allocation strategy.**
- 2           **(D) Member services.**
- 3           **(E) Member communications."**
