A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION to recognizing Indiana's Asian American Community as it recognizes the Lunar New Year Day of February 5, 2000

Whereas, The first day of Lunar New Year is February 5, 2000; and

Whereas, The Lunar New Year is an important holiday and part of Asian American culture; and

Whereas, Cultural diversity is a strength of this nation; and

Whereas, Indiana is committed to cultural diversity and celebrating our cultural diversity is important to our community;

Be it resolved by the Senate of the
General Assembly of the State of Indiana, the House of
Representatives concurring;

SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly hereby recognizes the importance to the Asian American Community of Indiana as it celebrates February 5, 2000 as "Lunar New Year Day".
