SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the department of transportation to designate US 421 in Jefferson County from the junction of SR 62 in Madison, Indiana, to the northern border of Madison, Indiana, as the "Veterans Memorial Highway" in honor of the Jefferson County veterans.

Whereas, The General Assembly recognizes the great sacrifices made by Indiana veterans in the service of their country in time of war;

Whereas, Many states, including Indiana, have designated and named parts of state and federal highways as memorials to those who served their nation in time of war;

Whereas, The people of Jefferson County wish to recognize the designation of US 421 in Jefferson County from the junction of SR 62 in Madison, Indiana, to the northern border of Madison, Indiana, in honor of the Jefferson County veterans; and

Whereas, It is, therefore, fitting that the proper signage be placed along US 421 in Jefferson County from the junction of SR 62 in Madison, Indiana, to the northern border of Madison, Indiana, to recognize the designation of that part of the highway as the "Veterans Memorial Highway" in honor of these veterans: Therefore,

Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:



1 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly urges the
2 department of transportation to rename US 421 in Jefferson County
3 from the junction of SR 62 in Madison, Indiana, to the northern border
4 of Madison, Indiana, as the "Veterans Memorial Highway" in honor of
5 the veterans from Jefferson County.

6 SECTION 2. That copies of this resolution be transmitted by the
7 Secretary of the Senate to Tony Brooks, President of American Vets
8 Motorcycle Support Club and the commissioner of the Indiana
9 department of transportation.
