SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION to endorse the process for Indianapolis, Indiana to obtain an NCAA Division I post season football bowl game.

Whereas, the people of this great state strongly desire and embrace the opportunity to obtain a site in Indianapolis, Indiana for an NCAA Division I post season football bowl game;

Whereas, over the past two decades, Indianapolis has established itself as the amateur sports capital of the world;

Whereas, Indianapolis serves as a venue for various amateur sports championships and trials including Men's and Women's Olympic and NCAA Division I basketball, Olympic and NCAA swimming, diving, and rowing, Olympic and NCAA cycling, and NCAA track and field;

Whereas, in support of the advancement of sports, Indianapolis has dedicated millions of dollars to build state-of-the-art sports facilities, including the RCA Dome, Natatorium, Outdoor Track and Field Stadium, Major Taylor Velodrome, Tennis Center, National Institute of Fitness and Sport, and Conseco Fieldhouse;



Whereas, Indianapolis, with its recent, attractive downtown renovation, would be a popular midwestern NCAA Division I football bowl game site; and

Whereas, the Indianapolis RCA Dome would ideally serve as a convenient backyard venue for an NCAA-organized event: Therefore,

Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:

1 SECTION 1. That, in keeping with its rich heritage in support of
2 amateur athletics, the people of Indiana hereby strongly embrace the
3 opportunity for this great state to obtain a site in Indianapolis, Indiana
4 for an NCAA Division I post season football bowl game.

5 SECTION 2. The Secretary of the Senate is directed to transmit a

7 Division I Championships Competition Cabinet liaison Tricia Bork,
