A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring the numerous accomplishments of the Whitko Future Farmers of America.

*Whereas, the Whitko Future Farmers of America chapter has recently won top honors in several state and national FFA competitions;*

*Whereas, the Whitko FFA team, comprised of Gretchen Imhoff, Jason Ewell, Liza Moore, and Phillip Camden, captured the 2000 State FFA Meats Career Development event at Purdue University with each team member also receiving individual recognition, including Jason Ewell, Liza Moore, and Phillip Camden placing 2nd, 4th, and 8th respectively, and Gretchen Imhoff receiving the high individual overall award;*

*Whereas, the Whitko FFA team, comprised of Pam Ousley, Jewel Wise, Leslie Weisenberger, and Joe Spangle, clinched the third place award at this event with Pam Ousley placing 9th overall individually;*

*Whereas, contestants are judged on their general knowledge of the meat industry, as well as on their ability to apply their skills to identify different meat cuts and to determine various quality characteristics of meat samples;*

*Whereas, the Whitko FFA team, including Liza Moore,*



*Jewel Wise, and Gretchen Imhoff, placed 4th in the National Western FFA Meats Judging contest in Denver, Colorado, with Liza Moore placing 9th overall individually;*

*Whereas, the Whitko FFA chapter also recently won the Keystone National Livestock Judging Contest in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania where the chapter was named national champion in the swine judging and oral reasons categories and placed second in beef and sheep judging categories;*

*Whereas, first, second and eighth place overall individual awards went to Liza Moore, Stacie Warner and Rita Wilkinson respectively;*

*Whereas, individual awards also went to Liza Moore for first place in beef judging and oral reasons and questions, second in swine judging and third in sheep judging; to Stacie Warner for first place in swine judging, second in reasons and tenth in sheep judging; and to Rita Wilkinson for sixth place in swine judging and ninth in sheep judging and oral reasons; and*

*Whereas, the Whitko FFA chapter will also represent Indiana at the 2000 National FFA Meats Contest in Louisville, Kentucky this fall: Therefore,*

*Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:*
