Synopsis: Parents as teachers programs. Specifies that parents as teachers programs are included among the parent information programs eligible to receive step ahead early childhood grant funds.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1417



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-1-1.8-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2001]: Sec. 4. As used in this
- 3 chapter, "eligible program" means a federal, state, local, or private
- 4 program or service aimed at serving, assisting, or otherwise benefiting
- 5 a child as approved by the governor and the panel under guidelines
- 6 developed under section 17 of this chapter. The term includes the
- 7 following programs or services:
- 8 (1) Child care.
- 9 (2) Preschool, including special education preschool.
- 10 (3) Parent information, **including parents as teachers.**
- 11 (4) School age child care (commonly referred to as latch key) as
- 12 described in IC 12-17-12-5 and IC 20-5-2-1.2(c), including latch
- 13 key services for kindergarten pupils.
- 14 (5) Early identification and early intervention.
- 15 (6) Maternal and child nutrition.
- 16 (7) Health and screening.
