**Summary of Legislation:** The bill adds a resident of a housing project to a housing authority. This bill also provides for the appointment of the resident member of an initial housing authority. It provides that the chairman of a housing authority may vote only in order to break a tie.

**Explanation of Local Expenditures:** Current statute gives the following compensation for commissioners of city housing authorities:

- A) A per diem allowance of twenty-five dollars for attending a meeting of the authority.
- B) Reimbursement is granted for necessary expenses, including traveling costs incurred in carrying out the duties of a commissioner.

The addition of a member could increase local expenditures by \$25 per each meeting attended and necessary reimbursement. These expenses would be paid out of the fiscal body's general fund.
