Summary of Legislation: (Amended) The bill adds two members to a housing authority. The bill also provides that for a city, one member must be a resident of a housing project. It provides that for a town or county, one member must be a person directly assisted by a housing authority. This bill also provides for the initial appointment of the additional housing authority members.

Effective Date: July 1, 2001.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: (Revised) Current law allows the following compensation for commissioners of city housing authorities:

- A) A per diem allowance of twenty-five dollars for attending a meeting of the authority.
- B) Reimbursement is granted for necessary expenses, including traveling costs incurred in carrying out the duties of a commissioner.

The addition of two members would increase local expenditures by \$50 per each meeting attended and could include any necessary reimbursement granted. These expenses would be paid out of the fiscal body's general fund.
