Summary of Legislation: Repeals the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction Law and replaces it with the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction Act providing for clearer standards regarding interstate child custody modification jurisdiction. Establishes a process to enforce interstate child custody and visitation determinations with uniformity and harmonizes the law with respect to simultaneous proceedings and inconvenient forums.
