Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill requires a person who lays out a subdivision of lots or lands outside a municipality to obtain the approval of the county drainage board or technical review committee of the plans and specifications for the drainage of the subdivision tract before proceeding with development of the subdivision tract. The bill specifies the standards that the plan and specifications must comply with. It provides that the county drainage board or technical review committee may approve an alternate design that does not comply with the standard concerning the entrance and exit of surface water.
