MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1118 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 3, after line 19, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 7. IC 7.1-5-10-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.205-1999,
- 3 SECTION 18, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 JULY 1, 2001]: Sec. 1. (a) Except as provided in subsection (d), it is
- 5 unlawful to sell alcoholic beverages at the following times:
- 6 (1) At a time other than that made lawful by the provisions of
- 7 IC 7.1-3-1-14.
- 8 (2) On Christmas Day and until 7:00 o'clock in the morning,
- 9 prevailing local time, the following day.
- 10 (3) On primary election day, and general election day, from 3:00
- 11 o'clock in the morning, prevailing local time, until ~~the voting polls~~
- 12 ~~are closed in the evening 6 p.m.~~ on these days.
- 13 (4) During a special election under IC 3-10-8-9 (within the
- 14 precincts where the special election is being conducted), from
- 15 3:00 o'clock in the morning until ~~the voting polls are closed in the~~
- 16 ~~evening 6 p.m.~~ on these days.
- 17 (b) During the time when the sale of alcoholic beverages is
- 18 unlawful, no alcoholic beverages shall be sold, dispensed, given away,
- 19 or otherwise disposed of on the licensed premises and the licensed
- 20 premises shall remain closed to the extent that the nature of the
- 21 business carried on the premises, as at a hotel or restaurant, permits.
- 22 (c) It is unlawful to sell alcoholic beverages on New Years Day for
- 23 off-premises consumption.
- 24 (d) It is lawful for the holder of a valid beer, wine, or liquor

1 wholesaler's permit to sell to the holder of a valid retailer's or dealer's
2 permit at any time.

3 **(e) Notwithstanding subsection (a)(3) and (a)(4), a person who,**
4 **on a primary, general, or special election day, knowingly possesses**
5 **alcoholic beverages at or in a polling location or within fifty (50)**
6 **feet of the door or entrance to a polling location commits a Class**
7 **B misdemeanor."**

8 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
