Synopsis: Groundwater quality rules. Removes the requirement that groundwater quality rules adopted by the water pollution control board must allow groundwater remediations to be consistent with statutory remediation objectives "as appropriate".

SENATE BILL No. 243

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 13-12-3-2, AS ADDED BY P.L.224-1999,
2 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 2. (a) The remediation and closure goals,
4 objectives, and standards for activities conducted under IC 13-22 and
5 IC 13-23 shall be consistent with the remediation objectives set forth
6 in IC 13-25-5-8.5.
7 (b) The groundwater quality standards adopted under IC 13-18-17-5
8 shall allow ~~as appropriate,~~ groundwater remediations to be consistent
9 with the remediation objectives set forth in IC 13-25-5-8.5.
10 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
