

# HOUSE BILL No. 1158

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 14-12-2-21.

**Synopsis:** Heritage trust project procedures. Provides that whenever the Indiana heritage trust program plans to acquire property, the department of natural resources must conduct a public hearing in the county where the property is located.

**Effective:** July 1, 2001.

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## HOUSE BILL No. 1158



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 14-12-2-21 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2001]: Sec. 21. (a) The following
- 3 procedure must be followed before the department may acquire
- 4 property under this chapter:
- 5 (1) The project committee must propose a project to the trust
- 6 committee.
- 7 (2) The trust committee must approve the project proposed by the
- 8 project committee, with or without modifications, and recommend
- 9 the project to the governor for approval.
- 10 (3) **The department must conduct a public meeting in the**
- 11 **county where the property for the proposed project is located.**
- 12 (4) The governor must approve the project as recommended by
- 13 the trust committee and inform the director of the department of
- 14 the governor's approval.
- 15 (b) When the procedure under subsection (a) is completed, the
- 16 department shall acquire the property subject to the project according
- 17 to Indiana law.
