A BILL FOR AN ACT to repeal a provision of the Indiana Code concerning the constitutional duties of the general assembly.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 3-3-3 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE UPON
- 2 PASSAGE].
- 3 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
