DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-45-1-3.

Synopsis: Threats against persons or property in schools. Expands the offense of disorderly conduct to include acts of a person who recklessly, knowingly, or intentionally disrupts or interferes with the lawful activity of a school by threatening to inflict harm upon a person or damage property within or associated with the school.

Effective: July 1, 2001.

HOUSE BILL No. 1804



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-45-1-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2001]: Sec. 3. A person who
 3 recklessly, knowingly, or intentionally:
 4 (1) engages in fighting or in tumultuous conduct;
 5 (2) makes unreasonable noise and continues to do so after being
 6 asked to stop; ~~or~~
 7 (3) disrupts a lawful assembly of persons; **or**
 8 **(4) disrupts or significantly interferes with the lawful activity**
 9 **of a school by communicating a threat to:**
 10 **(A) inflict harm upon a person; or**
 11 **(B) damage property;**
 12 **within or associated with the school;**
 13 commits disorderly conduct, a Class B misdemeanor.
