

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1503 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 3, between lines 27 and 28, begin a new paragraph and insert:
 2 SECTION 2. IC 6-1.1-5.5-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2001]: Sec. 3. (a) Before filing a
 4 conveyance document with the county auditor under IC 6-1.1-5-4, all
 5 the parties to the conveyance must complete and sign a sales disclosure
 6 form as prescribed by the state board of tax commissioners under
 7 section 5 of this chapter. All the parties may sign one (1) form, or if all
 8 the parties do not agree on the information to be included on the
 9 completed form, each party may sign and file a separate form.
 10 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c), the auditor shall forward
 11 each sales disclosure form to the county assessor. The county assessor
 12 shall **retain the forms for five (5) years. The county assessor shall**
 13 forward the sales disclosure form **data** to the state board of tax
 14 commissioners, ~~and to the appropriate township assessor:~~ **in electronic**
 15 **format, if possible.** The county assessor shall ~~retain forward~~ a copy
 16 of the sales disclosure ~~form for the purposes established in~~
 17 ~~IC 6-1.1-4-13.6 and shall forward a copy forms~~ to the township
 18 assessors in the county. **The forms may be used by the county**
 19 **assessing officials and the state board of tax commissioners for the**
 20 **purposes established in IC 6-1.1-4-13.6, sales ratio studies,**
 21 **equalization, and any other authorized purpose.**
 22 (c) In a county containing a consolidated city, the auditor shall
 23 forward the sales disclosure form to the appropriate township assessor.
 24 The township assessor shall forward the sales disclosure form ~~to the~~
 25 ~~state board of tax commissioners.~~ The township assessor may retain a
 26 copy of the sales disclosure form for the purposes established in
 27 ~~IC 6-1.1-4-13.6.~~ **to the state board of tax commissioners, in**
 28 **electronic format, if possible. The township assessor shall forward**
 29 **a copy of the sales disclosure forms to the township assessors in the**
 30 **county. The forms may be used by the county assessing officials**
 31 **and the state board of tax commissioners for the purposes**
 32 **established in IC 6-1.1-4-13.6, sales ratio studies, equalization, and**

- 1 **any other authorized purpose.**
- 2 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
