Summary of Legislation: This bill increases from \$100,000 to \$500,000 the cost of a public works project a local unit may perform by the unit's own workforce without awarding a contract.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: The number of public works project contracts local units award between \$100,000 and \$500,000 is unknown. The bill has the potential of reducing construction costs if the project can be done by the local unit's employees.
