**Summary of Legislation:** Eliminates the home rule powers of a city, town, or county to impose a fire, police, or public safety service charge or fee on property that is exempt from property taxation. Prohibits special taxing districts and other political subdivisions from exercising the powers under a statute to impose a fire, police, or public safety service charge fee or user fee on exempt property or on the owner of exempt property.
