Summary of Legislation: Requires the state's Medicaid nursing home rate setting contractor to consider certain information when setting payment rates. Prohibits the office of the secretary of family and social services from: (1) repealing an administrative rule regarding reimbursement to Medicaid nursing homes; or (2) amending the rule or adopting additional rules to reduce payments to nursing homes without specific statutory authority. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the joint commission on Medicaid oversight.)
