DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-14-3-5; IC 9-29-2-2.

Synopsis: Fee for electronic access to BMV information. Provides that the fee for motor vehicle title or registration information is: (1) four dollars for a record requested in writing; (2) one dollar for a record requested electronically; and (3) four dollars for driver's license information requested in writing or electronically; plus any service fee charged by the intelenet commission.

Effective: July 1, 2002.

HOUSE BILL No. 1168



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-14-3-5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.225-1999,
2 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2002]: Sec. 5. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), (c), or
4 (d), the bureau shall prepare and deliver information on titles,
5 registrations, and licenses and permits upon the request of any person.
6 All requests must be:
7 (1) submitted in writing; or
8 (2) requested electronically through the computer gateway
9 administered by the intelenet commission under IC 5-21-1;
10 to the bureau and, unless exempted under IC 9-29, must be
11 accompanied by the payment of the appropriate fee prescribed in
12 IC 9-29-2-2.
13 (b) The bureau may not disclose the:
14 (1) Social Security number;
15 (2) federal identification number;
16 (3) driver's license number; or
17 (4) digital image of the driver's license applicant;



1 of any person except to a law enforcement officer or an agent or a
2 designee of the department of state revenue.

3 (c) As provided under 42 U.S.C. 1973gg-3(b), the commission may
4 not disclose any information concerning the failure of an applicant for
5 a motor vehicle driver's license to sign a voter registration application,
6 except as authorized under IC 3-7-14.

7 (d) The commission may not disclose any information concerning
8 the failure of an applicant for a title, registration, license, or permit
9 (other than a motor vehicle license described under subsection (c)) to
10 sign a voter registration application, except as authorized under
11 IC 3-7-14.

12 SECTION 2. IC 9-29-2-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
13 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2002]: Sec. 2. (a) The fee to obtain information
14 on titles **or** registrations **and driver's licenses** under IC 9-14-3-5 is:

- 15 (1) four dollars (\$4) for each record requested **in writing; and**
16 (2) **one dollar (\$1) for each record requested electronically**
17 **through the computer gateway administered by the intelenet**
18 **commission under IC 5-21-1;**

19 **plus any service fee charged by the intelenet commission.**

20 (b) **The fee to obtain information on driver's licenses under**
21 **IC 9-14-3-5 is four dollars (\$4) for each record requested either:**

- 22 (1) **in writing; or**
23 (2) **electronically through the computer gateway administered**
24 **by the intelenet commission under IC 5-21-1;**

25 **plus any service fee charged by the intelenet commission.**

26 (c) The fee imposed by this section **paid to the bureau** is in lieu of
27 fees established under IC 5-14-3-8 and does not apply to a law
28 enforcement agency or an agency of government.

29 SECTION 3. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2002] (a) **Notwithstanding**
30 **IC 9-29-2-2, as amended by this act, the fee charged for each**
31 **record of a motor vehicle title or registration that is requested**
32 **electronically through the computer gateway administered by the**
33 **intelenet commission under IC 5-21-1 is four dollars (\$4). The**
34 **intelenet commission may also charge a service fee.**

35 (b) **This SECTION expires January 1, 2003.**
