DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-2-14.

Synopsis: Coroner continuing education and training. Requires a county coroner to attend annually one continuing education and training program offered by the coroners training board. Provides that a county coroner who fails to attend a required continuing education and training program is liable to the county for up to \$500.

Effective: July 1, 2002.

HOUSE BILL No. 1205



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-2-14-14 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2002]: Sec. 14. (a) The coroner or
3 his representative shall, when invited, attend meetings of the
4 commission on forensic sciences for consultation on matters
5 concerning the interests of the commission, the office of coroner, or
6 both. The expenses of the coroner or his representative shall be paid
7 from the general fund of the county that the coroner serves, but may not
8 exceed the statutory amount per day for meals and lodging and a sum
9 for mileage at a rate determined by the county fiscal body.

10 **(b) It is a duty of the coroner to attend each year at least one (1)**
11 **continuing education and training program offered by the coroners**
12 **training board. The expenses of the coroner attending a continuing**
13 **education and training program shall be paid from the general**
14 **fund of the county that the coroner serves but may not exceed the**
15 **statutory amount per day for meals and lodging and a sum for**
16 **mileage at a rate determined by the county fiscal body.**

17 SECTION 2. IC 36-2-14-21 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE



1 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
2 1, 2002]: **Sec. 21. A coroner who fails to perform a duty imposed by**
3 **section 14(b) of this chapter is liable to the county in a sum of not**
4 **more than five hundred dollars (\$500), to be recovered in a civil**
5 **action brought in the name of the county.**
