

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 207 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:
2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
3 education and criminal history information.
4 Page 3, between lines 11 and 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:
5 "SECTION 2. IC 5-2-5-13, AS AMENDED BY P.L.272-2001,
6 SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
7 JULY 1, 2002]: Sec. 13. (a) The department may not charge a fee for
8 responding to a request for the release of a limited criminal history
9 record if the request is made by a nonprofit organization: ~~that:~~
10 (1) **that** has been in existence for at least ten (10) years; and
11 (2) ~~either:~~ **that:**
12 (A) has a primary purpose of providing an individual
13 relationship for a child with an adult volunteer if the request
14 is made as part of a background investigation of a prospective
15 adult volunteer for the organization; ~~or~~
16 (B) is a home health agency licensed under IC 16-27-1;
17 (C) **is a community mental retardation and other**
18 **developmental disabilities center (as defined in**
19 **IC 12-7-2-39); or**
20 (D) **is a supervised group living facility licensed under**
21 **IC 12-28-5.**
22 (b) The department may not charge a fee for responding to a request
23 for the release of a limited criminal history record made by the division
24 of family and children or a county office of family and children if the
25 request is made as part of a background investigation of an applicant
26 for a license under IC 12-17.2 or IC 12-17.4.
27 (c) The department may not charge a fee for responding to a request
28 for the release of a limited criminal history if the request is made by a
29 school corporation, special education cooperative, or non-public school
30 (as defined in IC 20-10.1-1-3) as part of a background investigation of
31 an employee or adult volunteer for the school corporation, special

- 1 education cooperative, or non-public school."
- 2 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
