DIGEST OF HB 1632 (Updated March 19, 2003 12:06 PM - DI 104)

Citations Affected: IC 12-15.

Synopsis: Premiums for Medicaid buy-in program. Specifies that the office of Medicaid policy and planning's (office) calculation of an individual's personal needs allowance includes income in addition to federal Supplemental Security Income. Requires the office to adjust, at additional times to the annual review, the premium for working disabled persons to participate in the Medicaid buy-in program. Requires the office to adjust the premium upon verification of a change in the person's income or family size.

Effective: July 1, 2003.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning Medicaid.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
