**Summary of Legislation:** This bill requires a juvenile court to recommend the suspension of a child's driving privileges if the child is found to have committed an act that would be a certain vehicular crime if committed by an adult.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2003.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** The Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) will suspend the driving privileges of juveniles in the same manner as they currently suspend licenses. In CY 2001, the BMV suspended approximately 133,500 licenses. The provisions of this proposal will not result in any increased expenditures for the BMV. The fund affected is the Motor Vehicle Highway Account which supports the BMV.
