**Summary of Legislation:** The bill conforms election law to the Federal Help America Vote Act (HAVA). Makes appropriations from the state General Fund to provide state matching funds required by the Federal HAVA. The bill establishes the State Election Administration Interim Study Committee (SEAIISC) to study issues relating to state election administration. The bill appropriates Federal money received under the Federal HAVA. The bill repeals superseded statutes relating to funding of voting systems.

**Effective Date:** Upon passage; July 1, 2003.
