Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill permits a bed and breakfast establishment to cater two meals per month to be served to a limited group on the premises of the bed and breakfast establishment.

Effective Date: July 1, 2003.

Explanation of State Expenditures: (Revised) Currently, bed and breakfast establishments are exempt from following retail food establishments' sanitary food requirements when preparing breakfast for its customers. This bill expands the exemption so that bed and breakfast establishments may also cater meals. It also provides that bed and breakfast establishments may cater meals to no more than 12 people and no more than two days per month.
