Summary of Legislation: This bill requires the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) to issue two license plates for all vehicles other than motorcycles, trailers, yard trailers, and semitrailers. It requires that license plates be displayed on the front and rear of a vehicle if two license plates have been issued for the vehicle. The bill makes conforming changes in related statutes. It establishes the Motor Vehicle Replating Fund. It specifies that the Bureau may set a fee to cover the costs of issuance of a second license plate and specifies that this fee be deposited in the Motor Vehicle Replating Fund.
