Summary of Legislation: This bill establishes grants for community learning programs for adults residing within the boundaries of a school corporation. The bill makes an appropriation of \$5,000,000 for the grants.

Effective Date: July 1, 2003.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill appropriates \$5 M for the 2003-2005 biennium from the state General Fund to fund grants for community learning programs. The program would be administered by the State Board of Education. The State Board of Education would give preference to community learning

programs that include:

1. Adult literacy programs;
2. Distance learning;
3. Health seminars; or
4. Health screening.

The state impact table above assumes that the appropriation would be split equally between FY 2004 and FY 2005.
