MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 2008 be recommitted to a Committee of One, its author, with specific instructions to amend as follows:

- 1 Page 82, between lines 27 and 28, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 64. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003] (a) **As used in this**
3 **SECTION, "commission" refers to the government efficiency**
4 **commission established by subsection (c).**
5 **(b) As used in this SECTION, "state educational institution" has**
6 **the meaning set forth in IC 20-12-0.5-1.**
7 **(c) The government efficiency commission is established.**
8 **(d) The commission consists of the following members:**
9 **(1) One (1) cochairperson appointed before July 16, 2003, by**
10 **the president pro tempore of the senate.**
11 **(2) One (1) cochairperson appointed before July 16, 2003, by**
12 **the speaker of the house of representatives.**
13 **(3) Ten (10) members appointed before August 16, 2003, by**
14 **the president pro tempore of the senate.**
15 **(4) Ten (10) members appointed before August 16, 2003, by**
16 **the speaker of the house of representatives.**
17 **(e) The following may not be members of the commission:**
18 **(1) An elected or appointed state or local official.**
19 **(2) An employee or a person receiving a pension or other**
20 **retirement benefit related to service to any of the following:**
21 **(A) A state educational institution.**
22 **(B) A school corporation or a charter school.**
23 **(C) The state or any agency of the state.**
24 **(3) A person who has a direct business relationship with any**

- 1 **of the following:**
- 2 **(A) A state educational institution.**
- 3 **(B) A public school corporation.**
- 4 **(C) The state or any agency of the state.**
- 5 **(D) An elected or appointed state agency official.**
- 6 **(E) The general assembly or any of its members.**
- 7 **(f) A member of the commission is not entitled to a salary per**
- 8 **diem.**
- 9 **(g) A member of the commission is entitled to reimbursement**
- 10 **for traveling expenses and other expenses actually incurred in**
- 11 **connection with the member's duties, as provided in the legislative**
- 12 **council's travel policies and procedures.**
- 13 **(h) The commission shall meet upon the call of the**
- 14 **cochairpersons.**
- 15 **(i) The cochairpersons may advise the president pro tempore of**
- 16 **the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives**
- 17 **concerning the appointment of other members of the commission.**
- 18 **(j) A quorum of the commission must be present to conduct**
- 19 **business. A quorum consists of a majority of the voting members**
- 20 **appointed to the commission.**
- 21 **(k) The commission may not take an official action unless the**
- 22 **official action has been approved by at least a majority of the**
- 23 **voting members appointed to serve on the commission.**
- 24 **(l) The cochairpersons shall establish and appoint commission**
- 25 **members to four (4) subcommittees as follows:**
- 26 **(1) The K-12 education subcommittee.**
- 27 **(2) The higher education subcommittee.**
- 28 **(3) The Medicaid and human services subcommittee.**
- 29 **(4) The general government subcommittee.**
- 30 **(m) The cochairpersons shall name the chairperson of each**
- 31 **subcommittee.**
- 32 **(n) The commission shall do the following:**
- 33 **(1) Review all state funded agencies, departments, and**
- 34 **programs.**
- 35 **(2) Make recommendations to improve efficiency and reduce**
- 36 **waste or other unnecessary costs associated with any state**
- 37 **funded agency, department, or program.**
- 38 **(o) The following persons shall serve as staff advisers to the**
- 39 **commission:**
- 40 **(1) The state budget director.**
- 41 **(2) The commissioner of the commission for higher education.**
- 42 **(3) The Indiana state board of education administrator.**
- 43 **(4) The executive director of the legislative services agency.**
- 44 **(p) The commission shall provide an interim report on its**
- 45 **activities to the governor and to the executive director of the**
- 46 **legislative services agency before November 30, 2003. The**
- 47 **commission shall provide its final recommendations before**

- 1 **November 30, 2004, to the following:**
- 2 **(1) The governor.**
- 3 **(2) The executive director of the legislative services agency.**
- 4 **(q) This SECTION expires January 1, 2005."**
- 5 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
