I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 479 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 11, between lines 22 and 23, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 16. IC 35-37-4.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 3 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 JULY 1, 2003]:
- 5 **Chapter 4.5. Sex Crimes Victims and Polygraph Examinations**
- 6 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "polygraph instrument" has the**
- 7 **meaning set forth in IC 25-30-2-1.**
- 8 **Sec. 2. A law enforcement officer shall not require an alleged**
- 9 **victim of an offense described in IC 35-42-4 to submit to a**
- 10 **polygraph examination.**
- 11 **Sec. 3. A law enforcement officer shall not refuse to investigate,**
- 12 **charge, or prosecute an offense under IC 35-42-4 solely because the**
- 13 **alleged victim has not submitted to a polygraph examination.**

1 **Sec. 4. This chapter does not prohibit an alleged victim of an**
2 **offense under IC 35-42-4 from voluntarily submitting to a**
3 **polygraph examination."**

4 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
