Synopsis: Bed and breakfast kitchen operations. Permits a bed and breakfast establishment to cater two meals per month to be served to a limited group on the premises of the bed and breakfast establishment.

HOUSE BILL No. 1595

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-41-31-8 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2003]: **Sec. 8. (a) Not more than two (2) days each month, a bed
4 and breakfast establishment may provide food to a group of not
5 more than twelve (12) individuals that hires the bed and breakfast
6 establishment to cater meals on the premises of the bed and
7 breakfast establishment.**

8 **(b) A bed and breakfast establishment is not required to obtain
9 an additional license to cater meals under this section.**

Page 1, line 8, delete "(2)" begin a new paragraph and insert: "**(b) A bed and breakfast establishment**".
