DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-4-3.7.

Synopsis: Definitions of trade mission and trade show. Amends the definition of "trade mission" in the law concerning the department of commerce to include a planned tour of business locations inside the United States. Amends the definition of "trade show" to include an exhibition, an exposition, or a fair located inside the United States.

Effective: July 1, 2003.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 4-4-3.7-2.5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003]: Sec. 2.5. As used in this
3 chapter, "trade mission" means a planned tour of business locations, all
4 of which are:

- 5 (1) located **inside or** outside the United States; and
- 6 (2) recommended by:
 - 7 (A) the United States Department of Commerce Foreign
 - 8 Commercial Service;
 - 9 (B) the United States Department of Agriculture Foreign
 - 10 Agriculture Service; or
 - 11 (C) the department of commerce.

12 SECTION 2. IC 4-4-3.7-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
13 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003]: Sec. 3. As used in this
14 chapter, "trade show" means an exhibition, **an** exposition, or **a** fair:

- 15 (1) located **inside or** outside the United States; and
- 16 (2) recommended by:
 - 17 (A) the United States Department of Commerce Foreign
