DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Immunity for smallpox vaccines. Provides immunity to a hospital or a hospital employee for personal injury that results from the administration of a smallpox immunization.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning civil procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 34-30-12.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 2 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 3 JULY 1, 2003]:
 4 **Chapter 12.5. Health Care: Immunity of Hospitals and Certain**
 5 **Persons Providing Smallpox Immunizations**
 6 **Sec. 1. A hospital that:**
 7 **(1) is licensed under IC 16-21; and**
 8 **(2) has been requested to provide smallpox immunizations by**
 9 **the state department of health;**
 10 **and its employees and agents are immune from civil liability for**
 11 **any personal injury that results from the administration of a**
 12 **smallpox immunization, except for acts or omissions amounting to**
 13 **gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct.**
