## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Synopsis:** High school diplomas for certain veterans. Provides that veterans of the Korean and Vietnam conflicts who, because of military service, left a public or nonpublic high school without graduating may receive a diploma.

# HOUSE BILL No. 1152



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-10.1-30-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.127-2002,
- 2 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 3 JULY 1, 2003]: Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "eligible veteran" refers
- 4 to an individual who has the following qualifications:
- 5 (1) Served as a member of the armed forces of the United States
- 6 at any time during at least one (1) of the following periods:
- 7 (A) Beginning April 6, 1917, and ending November 11, 1918
- 8 (World War I).
- 9 (B) Beginning December 7, 1941, and ending December 31,
- 10 1946 (World War II).
- 11 **(C) Beginning June 27, 1950, and ending January 31, 1955**
- 12 **(Korean Conflict).**
- 13 **(D) Beginning August 5, 1964, and ending May 7, 1975**
- 14 **(Vietnam Conflict).**
- 15 (2) Before the military service described in subdivision (1):
- 16 (A) attended public or nonpublic high school in Indiana; and
- 17 (B) was a student in good standing at the high school



- 1           described in clause (A), to the satisfaction of the department
- 2           of veterans' affairs.
- 3           (3) Did not graduate or receive a diploma because of leaving the
- 4           high school described in subdivision (2) for the military service
- 5           described in subdivision (1).
- 6           (4) Was honorably discharged from the armed forces of the
- 7           United States.
