HOUSE BILL No. 1595



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-41-31-8 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2003]: **Sec. 8. A bed and breakfast establishment:**
4 **(1) may provide food to a group of more than three (3)**
5 **individuals that hires the bed and breakfast establishment to**
6 **cater meals on the premises of the bed and breakfast**
7 **establishment; and**
8 **(2) is not required to obtain an additional license to cater**
9 **meals under this section.**
