A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2003]: **Sec. 6.5. "Graduation rate" means the**
4 **graduation rate for a high school:**
5 **(1) determined by the method described in 511 IAC 6.1-1-2;**
6 **and**
7 **(2) calculated by the department.**
