Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill requires the guardian, stepparent, or relative who accompanies, during practice driving, the holder of a motor vehicle learner's permit who is less than 18 years of age to: (1) be at least 18 years of age; (2) hold a driver's license; and (3) sit in the front seat. It requires a holder of a probationary driver's license who operates a motor vehicle with passengers to be accompanied in the front seat by another individual who: (1) holds an operator's license; and (2) is at least 18 years of age.
