Summary of Legislation: The bill specifies certain additional groups of students who are not included in determining a school's graduation rate.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: Under the bill, school corporations could require additional administrative time to track missing students. School corporations would have to track students that transfer from out of state during the school year.

Under current law, the Indiana Clearinghouse for Information on Missing Children (the clearinghouse) under the Indiana State Police must distribute a quarterly report to schools of missing children.

School corporations with missing students would need to note any missing students from the clearinghouse report. School corporations would then need to forward that information to the Department of Education for the calculation of the graduation rate.
