**Summary of Legislation:** This bill provides that an implement of husbandry and a farm tractor manufactured after June 30, 2005, must be fitted with equipment that meets certain national standards when operated on a highway. It requires the Criminal Justice Institute to adopt rules for the design of a slow moving vehicle emblem.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2004.
