MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 100 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 3, between lines 41 and 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 2. IC 4-20.5-6-2.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
3 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2004]: **Sec. 2.5. For property:**
5 **(1) controlled by the department under section 2 of this**
6 **chapter; and**
7 **(2) displaying the flags of the United States and Indiana;**
8 **the department shall fly the POW/MIA flag, as approved under 36**
9 **U.S.C. 902, at all times with the flags of the United States and**
10 **Indiana in the manner provided under 4 U.S.C. 7.**
11 SECTION 3. IC 8-23-5-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
12 A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
13 2004]: **Sec. 9. At rest areas on the interstate highway system, the**
14 **department shall fly the POW/MIA flag, as approved under 36**
15 **U.S.C. 902, at all times with the flags of the United States and**
16 **Indiana in the manner provided under 4 U.S.C. 7.**
17 SECTION 4. IC 10-11-2-20, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2003, SECTION
18 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
19 2004]: **Sec. 20. (a) The superintendent shall establish headquarters and**
20 **stations in localities the superintendent considers advisable for the**
21 **enforcement of the laws of the state.**
22 **(b) Within the limits of appropriations, the superintendent may do the**
23 **following:**

- 1 (1) Purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire suitable places, lands,
- 2 buildings, or rooms as local headquarters.
- 3 (2) Erect and equip buildings and headquarters as necessary.
- 4 (3) Purchase or otherwise acquire motor equipment, horses, and
- 5 other services, commodities, and equipment the superintendent
- 6 considers essential for the needs of the employees of the
- 7 department in carrying out their duties.
- 8 (4) Discontinue any headquarters or stations if the superintendent
- 9 considers it desirable for the proper enforcement of the laws of
- 10 the state.
- 11 (5) Purchase and install any approved standard mechanical devices
- 12 or equipment for the instantaneous or rapid transmission or
- 13 broadcasting of any information concerning crime or the
- 14 apprehension of criminals.
- 15 **(6) Fly the POW/MIA flag, as approved under 36 U.S.C. 902,**
- 16 **at all times with the flags of the United States and Indiana in**
- 17 **the manner provided under 4 U.S.C. 7.**
- 18 (c) The superintendent, with the approval of the board, may sell,
- 19 dispose of, or destroy property that becomes unnecessary or unfit for
- 20 further use by the department. Any money received from a sale under
- 21 this subsection shall be deposited in the state treasury as a special fund
- 22 to be used for the purchase of new equipment. The fund does not
- 23 revert to the state general fund.
- 24 (d) Authority vested in the superintendent under this section shall be
- 25 exercised with the approval of the board."
- 26 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
