DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 11-10-12-4.

Synopsis: Voting rights of discharged criminal offenders. Requires the department of correction to: (1) inform a discharged criminal offender in writing of the person's right to register to vote; and (2) to provide the criminal offender with a copy of the state voter's bill of rights.

Effective: July 1, 2004.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning corrections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 11-10-12-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2004]: Sec. 4. Upon the discharge
 3 of a criminal offender, the department shall **do the following:**
 4 (1) Certify the discharge to the clerk of the sentencing court,
 5 ~~Upon receipt of the certification, the clerk who~~ shall make an
 6 entry on the record of judgment that the sentence has been
 7 satisfied.
 8 (2) **Inform the criminal offender in writing of the right to**
 9 **register to vote under IC 3-7-13-5.**
 10 (3) **Provide the criminal offender with a copy of the voter's**
 11 **bill of rights prescribed by the Indiana election commission**
 12 **under IC 3-5-8.**
