DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-22-5-8; IC 15-7-10.

Synopsis: Biofuels. Requires the use of blended biodiesel fuel in state vehicles and tractors when feasible. Establishes the biofuels task force as a permanent legislative study group operating under the policies of the legislative council.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning agriculture and animals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 5-22-5-8, AS ADDED BY P.L.274-2001.
2	SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	JULY 1, 2004]: Sec. 8. (a) This section does not apply to a political
4	subdivision.

- (b) As used in this section, "blended biodiesel" has the meaning set forth in IC 6-3.1-27-2.
- (b) (c) As used in this section, "ethanol" means agriculturally derived ethyl alcohol.
- (c) (d) As used in this section, "gasohol" means gasoline that contains:
 - (1) at least ten percent (10%) ethanol; or
 - (2) ethyl tertiary butyl ether (ETBE) additives derived from ethanol.
- (d) (e) As used in this section, "gasoline fueled vehicle" refers to a vehicle that is capable of using gasoline to fuel its primary motor.
 - (e) (f) As used in this section, "vehicle" includes the following:
 - (1) An automobile.

3	(f) (g) Except as provided by subsection (g), (i), a governmental
4	body shall whenever possible purchase gasohol to fuel the gasoline

24	Chapter 10. Biofuels Task Force
25	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "biofuels" includes biodiesel,
26	ethanol, and other agriculture based alternatives to petroleum
27	based fuels.
28	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "task force" refers to the biofuels
29	task force established by this chapter.
30	Sec. 3. The biofuels task force is established.
31	Sec. 4. The task force consists of eleven (11) members as follows:
32	(1) Two (2) members of the house of representatives
33	appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.
34	(2) Two (2) members of the house of representatives
35	appointed by the minority leader of the house of
36	representatives.
37	(3) Two (2) members of the senate appointed by the president
38	pro tempore of the senate.
39	(4) Two (2) members of the senate appointed by the minority
40	leader of the senate.
41	(5) Three (3) members appointed by the governor.
42	Sec. 5. In making appointments under this chapter, the governor



1	shall give special consideration to persons who are members of or

3	(1) Farm organizations.	
4	(2) Fat and oil processors.	
5	(3) Petroleum producers and refiners.	
6	(4) Environmental and public health interest groups.

10	Sec. 6. Each member of the task force serves at the pleasure of	
11	the person who appointed the member.	
12	Sec. 7. The task force shall operate under the legislative	
13	council's policies governing study committees.	
14	Sec. 8. The legislative services agency shall serve as staff to the	
15	task force.	
16	Sec. 9. The task force shall do the following:	
17	(1) Investigate methods to increase research, development,	
18	production, and use of biofuels.	
19	(2) Advise the commissioner of agriculture on matters related	
20	to biofuels.	
21	(3) Give priority consideration to review of biofuel projects	
22	and policies that will provide maximum economic and	
23	environmental benefits to Indiana.	
24	(4) Submit recommendations to the legislative council and to	
25	legislative committees that have subject matter jurisdiction	
26	over biofuel matters as directed by the legislative council. The	
27	submissions to the legislative council must be in an electronic
