HOUSE BILL No. 1166



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-6.1-3-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2004]: **Sec. 13. (a) The board shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2**
4 **requiring a teacher to complete at least two (2) hours of training in**
5 **special education before a teacher's license may be renewed under**
6 **this article.**

7 **(b) The training requirement under subsection (a) must be**
8 **included in a teacher's:**

- 9 (1) continuing education requirements;
 - 10 (2) graduate course requirements; or
 - 11 (3) other similar license renewal requirements;
- 12 **as set forth by the board for a license renewal under this article.**

13 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2004] **(a) IC 20-6.1-3-13, as**
14 **added by this act, does not apply to a teacher (as defined in**
15 **IC 20-6.1-1-8) who completes the requirements for renewal of a**
16 **teacher's license under IC 20-6.1 before June 30, 2004.**

17 **(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2009.**
